Position Title:	Equipment Operator/Work Crew
FLSA Status:	Non-Exempt

Essential Job Functions/Duties:

1. Ability to safely and effectively operate construction/maintenance equipment including tractors, boom mowers, bull dozers, tracked loaders, excavators, pick-up trucks, etc.
2. Perform semi-skilled maintenance tasks, flagging traffic, tire repair, etc.
3. Ability to safely operate powered tools including chainsaws, drills, grinders, etc.
4. Ability to perform manual labor tasks including digging, chopping, carrying, etc.
5. Ability to work in all weather conditions, including extreme heat/cold and inclement weather
6. Must be able to work as a member of a team to safely complete assigned tasks and goals
7. Must be able to understand and follow oral instructions
8. Must be able to perform heavy manual labor
9. May be required to be on-call 24 hours a day during severe weather or declared emergencies
10. May be required to work more than 40 hours a week

Required Qualifications:

1. Graduation from High School or General Education Development (GED) certificate
2. Must have a valid Class C Texas driver's license with a clean driving record
3. Must be able to obtain a CDL within one year of employment
4. Knowledge of the operation and maintenance requirements of power-driven equipment
5. Knowledge of practices, methods, and materials used to construct/maintain drainage channels
6. Knowledge of traffic laws, ordinances and rules related to heavy equipment operations
7. Must be able to pass a drug test as a condition of employment, and may be subject to additional, post-employment drug testing as allowed by law

Working Conditions

Working conditions are primarily outside, with exposure to weather conditions; exposure to noise, dust, dirt, grease, oil and fuel; travel on public roads to and from worksite; working in and near water including creeks and ditches; operating tractors, mowing equipment and construction equipment.

Will work as part of a crew or individually under the supervision of the foreman and management of the Brookshire-Katy Drainage District.
